# **NSTEDB, DST - ISBA INITIATIVES**



TTHE NATIONAL SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT BOARD (NSTEDB), DST, GOVT. OF INDIA WHICH IS A PIONEER IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE INCUBATION MOVEMENT HAS BEEN SUPPORTING ISBA SINCE THE INCEPTION OF ISBA.

The dynamic nature of techno-entrepreneurship and the high risk associated with start-up ventures pose several challenges to Incubators in the effort to nurture entrepreneurship and promote start-ups. In addition, the grants provided to Incubators are time bound andhence Incubators that are established need to become sustainable within a relatively short period of time.

In order to meet objectives under programme, strengthen Incubation, and improve productivity of Incubators and to help in scaling up of activities, following interventions will be implemented with support NSTEDB

- a) Capacity Building
- b) Networking & Experience sharing
- c) Rewards and recognition

A proposal has been submitted to NSTEDB to extend financial support to organize the following events to the incubation managers:

The second programme of PFMS was organised at SINE, IIT Bombay, Mumbai and was beneficial to XX members on Jul 19 - 20, 2018












## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)**
